

# Modern Slavery Training

Modern slavery can be found in the supply chains of many organisations. The practises that constitute modern slavery are serious human rights violations and serious crimes. Globally, organisations are being increasingly required to eradicate the use of modern slavery in their supply chains and are more and more requested to be able to demonstrate this.

Modern Slavery is an informative two-module course which provides a unique opportunity for organisations to upskill and enhance their employees' understanding and awareness.



## Course Overview

This Modern Slavery course contains practical cases enabling staff to understand and detect modern slavery in their supply chains and gives insight in how to address and prevent modern slavery.



## Target Audience

- ▶ Understand several scenarios of modern slavery affecting organisations.

- ▶ How often modern slavery occurs in supply chains.
- ▶ How organisations may be unknowingly involved in modern slavery.
- ▶ How organisation can eliminate their involvement in modern slavery.

### Module 2: Preventing the use of modern slavery in supply chains

- ▶ Where modern slavery occurs in supply chains.
- ▶ The consequences for organisations of modern slavery occurring in their supply chains.
- ▶ The ongoing challenges for organisations where modern slavery occurs in their supply chains.
- ▶ How the use of modern slavery in supply chains can best be prevented.

At the end of every topic a knowledge check needs to be passed.
